

GC Question Sheet

Sermon: Acts 9:1-31

- **Have you struggled with doubt in your salvation? If so describe what that doubt meant for you** (this is not meant to be a guilt trip but to bring into the light struggles you might have)
- **What is grace? What is so great about it? Why do we need grace to be saved?**
- **Can you see your life being changed in the past because of the good news of Jesus coming and dying on the cross and then rising from the dead? If this is the case what are those moments?** (this is meant to be a time of encouragement not a time of pridefully boasting or trying to force proof of salvation) **If this is not the case, why do you think that is?** (this question is not meant to be a guilt trip but to have real and honest conversation in a GC)
- **What does it mean to live a life that is surrendered to the control or leadership of Jesus Christ? Why is this a key piece to our salvation from our sins?**
- **Conversion results in receiving the Holy Spirit. How do we know we have received the Holy Spirit if no one has laid hands on us or we haven't spoken in tongues or had a tongue of flame come over our head?** (For the GC Leader, it might be good to revisit [Loren's Sermon](#) that spoke on being Spirit-filled or watch this [video](#) on a Spirit-filled life from Wayne Grudem.)
