

GC Question Sheet

Sermon: Acts 12:25 – 13:12

- **If the Holy Spirit, in a very basic sense, is God in us. How have you experienced this in your life? Why do you think God made it possible to have Himself in us through the Holy Spirit? How does the Holy Spirit fit into the Gospel?**
- **In the church, we have regular habits to refocus on God and to worship Him. Do you think fasting is important as a regular habit of being a follower of Jesus? Why or Why not?**
- **What are the top distractions for you in your life that suck up your time in a non-productive or possibly over-productive (i.e. constantly thinking about work even when you are not working) way? Are there things you are constantly thinking about or worrying about after your “day-job” (i.e. a 9-5 job, taking care of the kids, university work, ect...)?**
- **What do you think it means to be sent out by the Holy Spirit? How do you know when the Holy Spirit is sending you? (use Acts 13:2-5)**
- **What are the things you are good at, gifted in? How do you think those skills/abilities/knowledge can be used in God’s kingdom? (if you don’t know that is okay, maybe your group sees things that you are good at or how you can use your abilities for God’s kingdom)**
- **Most of us have never been supernaturally blinded, but have you felt like you have been in the “mist and darkness” like the magician/false prophet? Describe that experience or perhaps describe how that is currently happening?**

- **What are the different ways you see the Holy Spirit acting that led Paul led out of blindness in Acts 9:1-19? In what ways do you see this leading you or someone else out of spiritual darkness? (perhaps read text out loud in group)**
- **What does it look like to be “astonished at the teaching of the Lord”? Why do you think there are times when the Bible or the Holy Spirit’s teachings become dull or boring? How does the Holy Spirit use those teaching moments in our daily lives?**
