

GC Question Sheet

Sermon: Acts 11:19-30

- How would you define discipleship? Do you know of any bible verses that you think of concerning discipleship?
- What is the Gospel? Why is it good news today? Think of someone in your everyday life who doesn't believe in Jesus. How is the Gospel good news for them? Why is it good news for the Fairbanks/Alaskan culture?
- How is Radiant/your Gospel Community "synergistic" (don't be afraid to google the definition) in spreading the Gospel? How could Radiant/your Gospel Community do better?
- In the text Acts 11:23 Barnabas strong encourages the believers in Antioch to
 "...remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast purpose." What does being faithful
 to the Lord look like in your life? What are the hardest areas in your life to
 remain faithful to the Lord? (This might be a good opportunity to commit as a GC
 or as a family to pray over these areas for a few months/a year)
- If a stranger came up to you in the street and asked what your unwavering purpose in life was how would you answer? How does/should the Gospel influence our purpose in life?
- Are you being discipled? Are you discipling someone? (typically we do these through DNA's but that is not the only way). If you are, are these relationships valuable to becoming more like Christ? If yes/no explain why? If you are not in a discipleship relationship why not?
- What are the costs of discipleship that you see? How did Jesus have similar costs in how He discipled? (the group should/can help with this) How is discipleship daunting? Why is discipleship worth the cost?
