

GC Question Sheet

Sermon: Acts 21:17-22:21

This series of questions is meant to help us go beneath the surface and help us draw closer to Jesus. This means being willing to have others speak into our lives and point us to Jesus. It means we also need to be willing, courageous, humble, and gracious in speaking Jesus into the lives of our family. It can be messy but it's worth it!

1. Glorifying God in the Good:

- a. Looking back over 2017 what are things that you can praise God for?
- b. In what ways did you see your life reflecting Jesus and what He cares about?
 - i. In good character?
 - ii. In good conversations about Jesus?
 - iii. In good deeds?
 - iv. In good confession?

2. Glorifying God in the Bad

- a. Looking back over 2017 in what things have been "bad" for you?
- b. In what ways did you see God show up? If you felt like God did not show up, why don't you think God showed up?

3. Glorifying God in the Ugly

- a. Looking back over 2017 what things have been "ugly" for you?
- b. In what ways did you see God show up? If you felt like God did not show up, why don't you think God showed up?

4. Glorifying God in 2018

- a. Are there specific things God is calling you to change to produce fruit in 2018 that we can be praying for?
- b. How can you be content when things go bad?



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- c. When things are bad/ugly how can you entrust yourself to God rather than trying to defend your position?
- d. When things are bad/ugly we can easily focus on ourselves in unhealthy ways (withdrawing from the family, addictions, ect..), how can you intentionally focus on following Jesus instead?
